1-30 November 2021	<u>Magdalen Hospital Trust</u>	Grants for project costs for charities working with vulnerable children and young adults, especially those at risk of sexual and other exploitation. Next grant panel in December.
31 October 2021	<u>Magic Little Grants</u>	Grants are available for groups that are either in their first year of operation or have an annual income under £250k.
Check website	<u>Morrison Foundation</u>	Grants to help get new projects off the ground that will benefit the local community, with special consideration for vulnerable and disadvantaged groups.
No specific deadline	<u>Newton Exhibition Foundation</u>	Grants to anyone who is or has been a pupil at a school in Hertford for education purposes.
#####	<u>MSE Charity</u>	Supports groups who deliver financial life skills, which make a lasting impact on the way people think, behave & manage their money.
05 January 2022	<u>Paradigm Grants Fund</u>	Grants are available to fund local activities that improve the quality of life of Paradigm residents and their communities.
